TARGET GROUP: ESOL AND BASIC SKILLS
Learners who may benefit from the Certificate in ESOL Skills for Life qualifications are

ESOL E1-3 EDEXCEL

Applicants will have a confidential initial interview to help plan individual learning programmes.

BASIC SKILLS: L1 -L2 EDEXCEL/NCFE

Course: BASIC SKILLS IN NUMERACY AND LITERACY
